

## 2018 ECC Men's Club Preview

The ECC Men's Club was busy again this offseason trying to develop a better golfing atmosphere for men at ECC. Despite over 100 male members that have a set of ... golf clubs, only about 20-30 of them regularly play in any golf events at ECC. This includes ERA, Wednesday Men's Day, mixed events or the men's tournament.

If you are in the majority that doesn't play, what's your excuse? No time, family in town, I'm not good enough, wife won't let me play, I don't know anybody, too much time at the office? If you find yourself in this position, let the ECC Men's Club help you get you on the golf course. The Men's Club was established nine years ago to bring golfers of all skill together to enjoy time on the golf course and then on the 19th hole where nobody has ever missed a shot! Here's what's on tap for this year's schedule.

#### Wednesday Evening Events

Starting Wednesday, May 23, there will be a regular Men's night event starting at 5:30 pm. Each week will have a different 9-hole event format and will accommodate golfers of all skill level. These events will shotgun start at 5:30 and the entry fee will be \$10/week.

New Proshop Manager Jen Thiel will run the events. If you are a previous Wednesday afternoon regular, perhaps you'd consider joining the evening bunch and if you hope to play 18, play the first 9 starting at 3:30 so you can join the action at 5:30.

#### **Special Golf Events**

The Men's Club will again host a structured Men's Guest Day on Wednesday, July 25 and all men playing that day will be required to participate and bring a guest. Guests enjoyed 18 holes of golf, on-course prizes, a steak dinner, drink tickets and a voucher good for 18-holes



to be used at a later date.

The final scheduled event of the 2018 ECC men's club season will be the annual match play championship in August. Last year's format proved to be extremely successful with various group play and round robin action. The format which was played from all teeboxes received strong reviews from the players.

The pay is the same across all groups so it's a good chance to help clean out the Proshop with some end of the season winnings!

#### **Social Events**

Most of the golfing community can attest that the best shots hit during the day are on the 19th hole. In 2018, the Men's Club is going to schedule a few social type events in an effort to connect active golfers with non-golfing members. Be on the lookout for e-mail blasts or Echo announcing these events.

#### **Dues and Handicaps**

During 2018, there will be significant emphasis on members establishing and maintaining a current handicap index. Handicaps enable golfers of all skill levels to compete on an equitable basis. Golfers must post all scores and regular posting will be monitored by the Proshop. Not posting scores regularly or accurately could preclude members from participation in certain men's club events.



The previously established bank account is nearly dry and without '18 dues, the enhanced payouts for the events will be gone.

Membership into the men's club is

optional however if you play in a sponsored event, you will be required to pay 2017 dues. This is a great way to support golf at ECC and the ECC Proshop.
