Dues and Handicaps

During 2017, there will be significant emphasis on members establishing and maintaining a current handicap index. Handicaps enable golfers of all skill levels to compete on an equitable basis. Golfers must post <u>all</u> scores and regular posting will be monitored by the Proshop. Not posting scores regularly or accurately could preclude members from participation in certain men's club events.

The 2017 ECC men's club dues are \$35 and will be billed accordingly. Dues have not been billed for several years due to billing limitations at the club. Membership into the men's club is optional however if you play in a sponsored event, you will be required to pay 2017 dues.

Note: This is a portion of a letter from Charles and Lyn McNeil to ECC. Charles McNeil's family were some of the first members of ECC. The McNeils have sold their Eshquaguma home and are moving to South Carolina.

... I certainly agree that ECC is a one of a kind Club, a true gem. I probably have appreciated its wonderful uniqueness more than most members. I only came to realize this after leaving the club in 1961 to take a sales position headquartered in Denver, then to Dallas and to Rhode Island. I searched each of those areas for a club that I could join. There was absolutely no club anything like ECC, with the closest being a country club in Rhode Island on the shores of Narragansett Bay. Annual dues were at least six times ECC which I believe were \$600. And that was a very inexpensive Club and it was

closed to new members. It is too bad that so few ECC members seem to appreciate what they have. I have been extremely fortunate to enjoy ECC for the better part of my life, and will certainly miss it.

We are hoping that Eshquaguma members will stop by to pay a visit when we are settled here in Beaufort next year. Our welcome mat will always be there for our many ECC friends. Hope you will stop by in '18.

Attention Golfers

Please try to avoid driving on the edges of the golf course. Members and member hired workers have been using the grass area along the road to park and drive on. There are noticeable "paths" being formed in these areas. Sometimes it is necessary to pull over when meeting another car, but there are also wide spots and paved parking areas which can be pulled into instead of always driving on the grass. Our golf course crew has done an excellent job getting the grounds into great shape after another winter. let's help them out by not ruining the rough along the course.

Members that were in the USGA/MGA GHIN handicap system last year but don't want to continue this year must notify the Pro Shop before **May 15th** or you will be charged a handicap fee and there will be no refunds. Most golf events at ECC require a USGA handicap.
